

New Creation Reality

Born again is the fundamental change of a person's nature.

It's not about repairing who you used to be it's when a completely *new being* appears. It wasn't an improvement but a total transformation a new spirit, a new person.

You become a *new being* (**John 1:12**).

Before Christ, you were not but after Christ, you became a divine-human creation.

Salvation was not an escape plan. It was what we can call *heaven's technology* for reproducing God in man. Now, God dwells in man in the form of His Spirit.

You are reconfigured by the very Words that gave you birth. The light of God fused with your spirit and became one a shared being.

Your spirit was fallen (as seen in *Genesis*, "My Spirit shall no longer strive with man"), meaning humanity died spiritually after the fall. But now, having received the Light, that same light fuses with the essence of God to create a completely *new creation*.

The Emergence of a New Species

2 Corinthians 5:17 "If any man comes to Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; the new is here."

The word *new* here is *kainos*, meaning "of a kind never seen before."

You're not just a forgiven sinner; you are the unveiling of a new order of being. That's why the world cannot define you because you were born of the incorruptible Word.

Your spirit vibrates with the frequency of God. That means you no longer carry fear or sin because those belong to the *Adamic field* the fallen realm that Christ destroyed.

The New Blueprint

You are no longer defined by the Adamic realm.

You must *deprogram your consciousness* from the old Adamic pattern and align it with the new divine blueprint.

You don't need to strive or sweat for change that struggle began after the fall ("By the sweat of your brow you shall eat..."). God never intended transformation to be achieved by striving.

Transformation Is Recoding

(Colossians 3:10, Ephesians 4:24)

Transformation is a deliberate *recoding* of your new being through awareness.

What you continually behold in the Word becomes what your consciousness works on. When you meditate on the Word, you invite your consciousness into the realm of God and as you behold, you become.

When the Word is truly believed, it restructures your body, mind, and entire being with divine programming.

Meditating on the Word programs your soul and removes everything unholy. It's not about trying hard not to disappoint God it's about remembering *who you are*. That remembrance begins to restructure your holy nature.

The Christian walk is not a journey of discovery but of remembrance ("He shall bring all things to your remembrance," referring to the Holy Spirit).

Sanctification is not just avoiding sin; it's the work of the Holy Spirit reconstructing your inner being until you begin to mirror the nature of God.

But the Spirit needs something within you to work with knowledge that He can quicken into revelation. When information becomes revelation, the Spirit begins restructuring your being. It's not just about reading the Bible; it's about becoming the revelation you receive.

The Renewed Mind

(Romans 12:2)

Renewing your mind allows you to walk in the acceptable will of God. It helps you identify what is wrong in your *mind*, not your spirit.

Your mind interprets spiritual data and gives it form. When God speaks, He speaks in *frequencies*, and your mind translates them into meaning.

If your mind is not renewed, the limitations of the Adamic nature will keep resurfacing. Renewal is not just learning new sermons it's a change of perception. You stop living from what happens *to* you and start living from what you *perceive*.

A renewed mind interprets from *eternity*, not from time. You begin to *command outcomes* into existence because you see from the eternal realm.

Every self-concept born of fear is a lie. You no longer identify with your past but with the resurrected Christ within you.

Righteousness as Nature

Righteousness is not behavior it's nature.

Just as a human being doesn't need to prove humanity, you don't need to prove righteousness. The Bible says we are *the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus* — meaning, by being in Him, you embody that nature.

You must walk in the authority of knowing that God lives *in* you, *through* you, and *as* you.

Manifesting Heaven

You're not just recreated you carry the atmosphere of God.

Miracles, peace, and authority are not events; they are *expressions* of who you are.

The environment you're in no longer dictates you *you* regulate it. You command things into alignment.

Every time you respond as your old self, you authorize the Adamic nature. But when you respond as your *new self*, you enforce the government of Heaven on Earth ("Let Your will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven").

Meditate intentionally and speak as a new creation until your subconscious aligns with that reality.

Don't just speak it see yourself living it.

Eliminate Old Patterns

Detach from old patterns fear, doubt, and self-condemnation. Through stillness and revelation (revelational prayer), realign your consciousness with divine truth.

Act boldly. Dominion is activated through expression.

Anchor yourself in the Word of God not as mere text, but as divine frequency. Feed on truth until it manifests in your consciousness, so your reality conforms to that truth.

The Divine Nature

You are no longer Adamic you are divine

You are an extension of Christ on Earth, restructured with divine truth and authority.

Walk with the awareness of who you are. Every environment you enter should yield to your nature. Rule from within. Speak from union. Manifest your heavenly authority.

You were *raised to reign* with Christ on Earth.
